## Museum of Cultural History

### PhD Research fellowship in technical art history

A position as PhD Research fellow is available at the Museum of Cultural History. The museum is part of the University of Oslo and houses one of the most important archaeological collections in Norway, including an outstanding collection of Norwegian medieval art.

In order to strengthen the research on and management of this collection, the museum welcomes project descriptions that combines conservation science and art history, and that has the museum's collections of medieval art as its subject. The project will be an independent one, in so far that it is not part of any larger museum project. Applicants should therefore document previous experience with independent work within the field requested. A strong interest in cultural heritage is a prerequisite. The candidate must hold a Norwegian Master's degree or equivalent in a relevant discipline, preferably conservation science or art history. Education and documented practice within the field of conservation science are, however, a prerequisite. The fellowship is for a period of three years and should not start later than 00.00.2013.

General demands and information.

Applicants must submit a project description (5-10 pages) outlining the research topic, the specific problems to be studied, the choice of scientific theory and method, and a schedule for the study. Any need for extra ordinary funding must be notified in the project description.

The application must be submitted in three sets and include:

- Application letter
- CV, summarizing education, positions and academic work
- Copies of educational certificates and letters of recommendation
- List of publications and other academic work (not more than two) that the applicant wishes to be considered by the evaluation committee
- Names and contact details of 2-3 references (name, relation to the candidate, e-mail and telephone number)

Application form for admission to relevant PhD program The fellowship includes a research training program. An approved plan for researcher training must be submitted not later than two month after taking up the position.
